## TSCA Declaration of Conformity

### Declaration relating to the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) – USA

#### 1. TSCA Section 6(h) – PBT substances

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has enacted measures under TSCA Section 6(h) to regulate the following Persistent, Bioaccumulative, and Toxic substances (PBTs):

- PIP (3:1) – phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (CAS 68937-41-7)
- DecaBDE – decabromodiphenyl ether (CAS 1163-19-5)
- HCBd – hexachlorobutadiene (CAS 87-68-3)
- PCTP – pentachlorothiophenol (CAS 133-49-3)
- TTBP – 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol (CAS 732-26-3)

Specific transitional arrangements and exemptions currently exist for certain substances, particularly PIP (3:1), according to current EPA publications.

Based on our current state of knowledge, our products do not contain any of these substances – or rather, they are not intentionally used.

#### 2. TSCA Section 8(a)(7) – PFAS reporting

According to the current requirements under TSCA Section 8(a)(7) regarding the reporting of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), the following applies:

- Manufacturers and importers (including importers of manufactured products) are required to report information on PFAS use.
- The regulation covers retrospective data (from 2011 onwards).

According to the information provided by our suppliers, our products do not contain any intentionally used PFAS.

#### 3. Data basis and liability

This declaration is based on information from our suppliers and available technical data sheets. No destructive testing or chemical analyses were performed.

This information reflects the current state of our knowledge. No warranty is provided and no liability is accepted for unknown factors or factors beyond our control.
