RoHS Declaration of Conformity

Declaration regarding Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS) and Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 on the Restriction of Hazardous Substances

Directive 2011/65/EU (RoHS – Restriction of Certain Hazardous Substances) and its amendments and modifications, including Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 and all current amendments, restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

1. Regulatory framework

The applicable substances and their associated limit values are listed in Annex II, currently as follows

• Mercury and its compounds	0.1%
• Lead and its compounds	0.1%
• Chromium (VI) compounds	0.1%
• Cadmium and its compounds	0.01%
• Polybrominated biphenyl (PBB)	0.1%
• Polybrominated diphenyl ether (PBDE)	0.1%
• Di(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
• Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
• Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
• Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

2. Declaration of conformity

Based on the information provided to us by our suppliers and available technical data sheets, we confirm:

- Our products comply with the requirements of Annex II of the RoHS Directive.
- This allows for applicable exemptions according to Annexes III and IV.

3. Notice regarding lead in copper alloys (Exemption 6(c))

Please note that our brass cable glands and their brass accessories have a lead content exceeding 0.1% by weight. Based on Exemption 6c in Annex III, these products still comply with Directive 2011/65/EU.

Exemption according to Annex III of Directive 2011/65/EU	
6c	Copper alloy with a lead content of up to 4% by weight

To the best of our knowledge, these products are being placed on the market, considering the applicable exemption, in compliance with the directive. RoHS Exemption 6(c) is currently valid until 30 June 2027. An extension request has been submitted, but a decision from the European Commission is still pending. Regulatory developments and any potential changes to this exemption are being continuously monitored.

4. Data basis and liability

This declaration is based on information from our suppliers and available technical data sheets. No destructive testing or chemical analyses were performed.

This information reflects the current state of our knowledge. No warranty is provided and no liability is accepted for unknown factors or factors beyond our control.
