EU POP Declaration of Conformity

Declaration on Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 relating to persistent organic pollutants (POPs)

Based on Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 relating to persistent organic pollutants (POPs), including all current amendments and adjustments, we confirm the following based on our current state of knowledge:

1. Regulatory framework

Persistent organic pollutants (POPs) are substances that are very long-lasting in the environment, bioaccumulative, and potentially toxic. The POP Regulation implements the requirements of the Stockholm Convention in the European Union.

2. Substance restrictions

The regulation contains, in particular in Annex I, prohibitions and restrictions on regulated substances. This list is regularly updated.

3. Declaration of conformity

Based on the information available to us from our suppliers and available technical data sheets, we confirm:

- Our products do not contain any persistent organic pollutants (POPs) as defined in Annex I of Regulation (EU) 2019/1021 – or rather, they are not intentionally used.
- To the best of our knowledge, any trace impurities are below the applicable regulatory limits.

4. Data basis and liability

This declaration is based on information from our suppliers and available technical data sheets. No destructive testing or chemical analyses were performed.

This information reflects the current state of our knowledge. No warranty is provided and no liability is accepted for unknown factors or factors beyond our control.
