PFAS Declaration of Conformity

Declaration on the control of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS)

Based on current regulatory developments in the area of per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), we confirm the following based on our current knowledge:

1. Regulatory framework

PFAS are a group of several thousand long-lasting chemical compounds with potentially critical environmental and health consequences.

European Union:

The ECHA has initiated a procedure to restrict the use of PFAS under the REACH Regulation. A final decision on the scope and timeline of the restriction is still pending.

United States:

TSCA Section 8(a)(7) defines a reporting requirement for PFAS which applies to manufacturers and importers (including products) and includes retrospective data (from 2011). There are also specific requirements in individual US states – in particular Maine (PFAS reporting from 2025), while other states have sector-specific bans and reporting requirements.

2. Declaration of conformity

- Our products do not contain any intentionally added PFAS.
- Any unintentional traces are, to the best of our knowledge, below relevant regulatory thresholds.

3. Note on materials that contain fluorine

Some materials, particularly fluoropolymers or fluoroelastomers (e.g. FKM), contain chemically bound fluorine.

These materials are not in general to be considered equivalent to the currently regulated PFAS, but they may be affected by future regulatory developments.

4. Data basis and liability

This declaration is based on information from our suppliers and available technical data sheets. No destructive testing or chemical analyses were performed.

This information reflects the current state of our knowledge. No warranty is provided and no liability is accepted for unknown factors or factors beyond our control.
