PPWR Declaration of Conformity

Declaration regarding Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on packaging and packaging waste

1. Regulatory status

The Packaging and Packaging Waste Regulation (PPWR) is a central component of the European circular economy policy and an essential part of the European Green Deal.

It replaces the previous Directive 94/62/EC and, for the first time, establishes uniform, binding requirements for packaging and packaging waste in all EU member states. The goal of the regulation is to reduce packaging waste, promote reuse, improve recycling, and thereby contribute to a climate-neutral economy by 2050.

Manufacturers who put packaging or packaged products on the market in the EU are required to provide technical documentation proving compliance with the PPWR and to issue a declaration of conformity.

2. Packaging systems

AGRO AG uses the following packaging systems:

- A) Cardboard box packaging systems
- B) Folding carton packaging systems
- C) Plastic bag packaging systems
- D) Conduit reel packaging systems
- E) PVC pipe packaging systems
- F) Euro pallet packaging systems
- G) Mixed pallet packaging systems

The packaging systems may include the following packaging components:

Cardboard boxes, folding boxes, plastic bags, cardboard reels, plastic pipes and tubes, plastic caps, euro pallet cardboard, euro pallet dividers, cardboard dividers, edge protectors, packing paper, tissue paper, adhesive tape, strapping tape/stretch tape, stretch film, labels, shipping envelopes, quality assurance seals/security seals

3. Classification of packaging systems

Product group	Packaging systems used
Electrical installation products	A; C; F; G
Connectivity products	A; B; C; F; G
Industrial products	A; B; C; E; G
Protective cable conduits	A; D; G

Packaging systems can also be used in combination.

4. Declaration of conformity

Our packaging systems and the included packaging components comply with the applicable material requirements under Regulation (EU) 2025/40 on Packaging and Packaging Waste (PPWR). This specifically includes compliance with the requirement defined in Article 5 regarding the limitation of heavy metals, including lead (Pb), mercury (Hg), cadmium (Cd) and chromium VI (Cr VI). Compliance with the requirements of the regulation is demonstrated by our technical documentation.

5. Responsibility and supporting documentation

As the producer and manufacturer of the packaged products, we are required to issue the declaration of conformity based on a conformity assessment procedure described in the regulation. Our technical documentation and other relevant evidence form the basis of this declaration. Upon request by the competent market surveillance authority, we will submit these documents for review. There are no plans to publish or make the technical documentation and other internal information generally available.

6. Data basis and liability

This declaration certifies compliance with the specified directives but does not constitute a warranty of any kind. The safety instructions in the product documentation must be followed if provided. This declaration of conformity is issued under the sole responsibility of the manufacturer.
