REACH Declaration of Conformity

Declaration regarding EU Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 on the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH)

1. Regulatory status

According to Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 (REACH: Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals), which entered into force on 01 June 2007, AGRO AG is considered a downstream user. AGRO AG distributes only non-chemical products (articles) and is therefore not required to register with or notify the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). AGRO AG expects its suppliers to comply with the requirements of REACH.

2. SVHC (Candidate List, Article 33)

On 04 February 2026, the ECHA published the latest update of the list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) in accordance with Regulation 1907/2006, on its website: <https://echa.europa.eu/en/candidate-list-table>. Updates are generally published every six months.

Please note that the following substances are on the SVHC list and are present in some elastomers of our products at a concentration greater than 0.1% by weight:

- **Bumetrizole (CAS No. 3896-11-5)**
- **Dodecamethylcyclohexasiloxane D6 (CAS No. 540-97-6)**
- **Dicumyl peroxide (CAS No. 80-43-3)**
- **n-Hexane (CAS No. 110-54-3)**
- **Bisphenol AF (CAS No. 1478-61-1)**

The SVHC list is a candidate list for Annex XIV of the REACH Regulation. However, the fact that a substance is on the SVHC list does not automatically mean that it is not REACH-compliant. It simply means that the substance candidate has been classified as particularly concerning by the submitting EU Member State or the ECHA and that certain legal obligations may apply for importers, producers and suppliers of the substance. However, it is important to note that the use of substances on the SVHC list can be restricted.

Based on the information available to us from our material suppliers and their data sheets, we currently assume that our products do not contain any other substances from the list of restrictions in a concentration exceeding 0.1% by weight.

AGRO AG regularly monitors updates to the ECHA list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs).

3. Specific notice – Lead in brass

In accordance with Article 33 of the REACH Regulation, we would like to further advise that our brass cable glands and their accessories may contain **lead (CAS No. 7439-92-1)** as an alloy component in a concentration exceeding 0.1% by weight. Under normal and foreseeable usage conditions, the lead cannot be released and therefore requires no additional instructions for safe use.

4. Restrictions (Annex XVII)

All products supplied by us comply with the requirements of Annex XVII of the REACH Regulation (EC) 1907/2006.

5. Data basis and liability

This declaration is based on information from our suppliers and available technical data sheets. No destructive testing or chemical analyses were performed.

This information reflects the current state of our knowledge. No warranty is provided and no liability is accepted for unknown factors or factors beyond our control.
