Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

KAISER GmbH & Co. KG is committed to comply with Section 1502 of the United States Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, also known as the U.S. Dodd-Frank Act. The act addresses the use of minerals such as:

Gold (Au), Tantalum (Ta), Tungsten (W) and Tin (Sn)

In manufacturing, that have been associated with financing regional violence and civil war in the Democratic Republic of Congo (“DRC”) and adjacent countries (“Conflict Region”) and thus commonly described as **“Conflict Minerals”**.

As a vendor of electrotechnical components, KAISER GmbH & Co. KG promotes traceability of Conflict materials and transparency of its products supply chain. We are committed to ensuring conflict free sourcing of formerly mentioned metals from our supply chain through close collaboration with our suppliers. Our efforts related to Conflict Minerals are aligned to the work of the Electronic Industry Citizenship Coalition (EICC®) and the Global e-Sustainability Initiative (GeSi).
